



A GENEROUS HAND. A GROWING FUTURE.

\$500,000 Awarded to the Foundation!

Yes, that's right. The Greene County Foundation along with 61 other Foundations in Indiana have been issued a challenge from the Lilly Endowment. Raise \$500,000 in unrestricted funds and they will match it dollar for dollar! This is the first time in 13 years that Lilly has offered this opportunity.



The Community Support Fund is helping to support the renovation of the Community Building, has supported the renovation of the FOP target range, helped build the Youth Baseball field in Linton, supported a new van for RIDE Solutions, a park in Worthington, a 5K in Jasonville, a downtown plan for Bloomfield and numerous other projects. By meeting the Lilly challenge The Greene County Foundation's grant making will DOUBLE. This is a wonderful opportunity to generate a lasting legacy by keeping local giving local for the benefit of local families and organizations. The match program will be in place through March 31, 2016. Consider a tax deductible contribution in each of three tax years, 2014, 2015, 2016 AND a 100% match on your contribution.



Become a Legend. The Foundation is announcing a **NEW** LEGACY Program. Our very successful Foundation 500 program is growing and new levels of recognition have been added. Anyone making a \$500 contribution to our unrestricted, ie Community Support Funds will be recognized on the Legacy Wall of our new offices. Once a donor's contributions reach \$10,000, or the Legacy Hero level, the donor will be recognized with a Community Support Fund in their name. Existing members of the Foundation 500 will be given credit toward the new levels in the Legacy program. At the \$100,000 Legend Level, a professional family

photo will be hung on the legacy wall in the new foundation offices and Legend members will have input, if they wish, into the grant awards each year. With the Lilly match, a \$5,000 contribution will meet the Level of Legacy HERO and a named fund, while a \$50,000 contribution will make a donor a Legend Level contributor.

The Lilly match period is August 1, 2014, through March 31, 2016.
